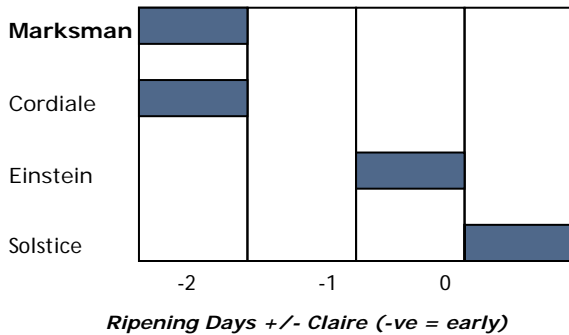


Winter Wheat - Parentage: 98ST08 x Aardvark

- Top end Group 2 wheat with high grain protein
- Early maturing for a secure harvest
- Excellent disease resistance

Early Maturity



Marksman is one of the earliest maturing milling wheat varieties on the 2009/10 Recommended List, allowing an early harvest to protect quality.

Yield & Quality

Marksman has a unique combination of high yields and high protein content. Along with a good specific weight and stable Hagberg Falling Number, this enables the milling specification to be met more reliably.

Marksman has shown very good baking performance from 5 years of independent and official testing, having essential quality attributes regarded as highly important by the major end-users.

Disease Resistance

Marksman's excellent disease resistance, particularly to the rusts and eyespot (from the *Pch1* gene\*) provides protection as demonstrated by the high untreated yield figure.
